

CHEVRON SCARF w/NORO

Skill Level- Beginner

Materials- (CC) 1 hank Noro Silk Garden (100g) and **(MC)** 100g of complimentary blue yarn in DK weight

Gauge- Gauge is not critical to this project; however, the pictured scarf was created on size 3 needles at a tension producing 5.5 stitches per inch in stockinette. A larger needle and heavier yarn will produce a wider scarf. KnitPicks' Chroma in a worsted weight would also make a lovely gradient chevron scarf.



Directions:

C/O 47 stitches (3 repeats of 15 stitches plus 2 edge stitches)

Stitch Pattern:

Row 1 (RS): Using MC: k1 (edge) *k2tog, k5, YO, k1, YO, k5, SSK* repeat end k1 (edge)

Row 2 (WS): Using MC: k all stitches

Row 3 (RS): Using CC: k1 (edge) *k2tog, k5, YO, k1, YO, k5, SSK* repeat end k1 (edge)

Row 4 (WS): Using CC: k all stitches

Repeat these 4 rows until the scarf is as long as desired. Then repeat the first two rows for symmetry and bind off in MC.
