

SCRAPPY COWL

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DIRECTIONS

CO 200 sts. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist. Place marker at BOR.

While following the directions, change between yarn colors as often as you'd like. I changed yarns every 1.5- 2.5 rounds.

Edging: Work in garter stitch for 5 rounds (knit one round, purl one round, knit one round, purl one round, knit one round).

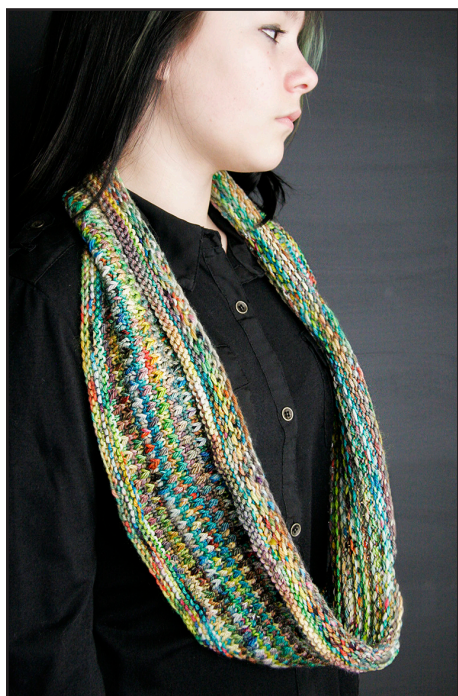
Pattern: Work Dimple stitch pattern over the next 46 rounds.

Edging: Work in garter stitch for 5 rounds (knit one round, purl one round, knit one round, purl one round, knit one round).

Bind off all stitches in purl stitch. Using a tapestry needle, weave in ends. Wet block.



What started out as 5 mismatched left-over balls of hand painted yarn turned into my favorite neck warmer! The color changes combined with the slipped stitches make the colors sing. It is totally worth weaving in the ends to get the color variations.



Dimple Stitch:

Rounds 1 & 2: *k1, sl1; rep from * to end of round
Round 3 & 4: k
Round 5 & 6: *sl1, k1; rep from * to end of round
Round 7 & 8: k

Skill Level- Beginner

Finished Measurements- 43" around and 5.75" tall

Yarn- 250 yds of worsted weight leftovers (shown here using 5 different leftover color-ways in hand painted Felicity yarn found in my [Etsy](#) shop)

Gauge- 4.5 stitches per inch and 6.25 rpi in stockinette with size 7 needle

Skills Required- Knitting in the round, knit, purl, slipped stitches.
